Enrollment:

Student and parent fill out the application portion of this handbook. Return filled-out and signed application with enrollment fee (see cost below) to Anahi in the office by Oct. 8th. No personal ukulele is required to enroll but is encouraged to allow practice at home.

Dismissal/Pickup:

Please make sure you and your child knows how they are getting home after choir rehearsal. If your child has a sibling, please make sure the sibling knows the plan as well. If your student participates in:

SKEF- they will be dismissed at 4:30 with their belongings, and go straight to snack time in the cafeteria.

Pick-up- Outside music room door. **Please be ready waiting for your child before rehearsal is over--**Let's respect everyone's time. Siblings will also wait by the music room door.

Walking Home- If your child walks to school then they will be free to walk home at 4:30. No staff is available to accompany walkers.

Expectations:

Attendance- Students will not be excluded from Strummerz rehearsals because of absence. However, significant absence from rehearsals will result in dismissal from the concert. Missing 6 or more rehearsals will be considered significant. As with math, we learn new skills every day and to expect a student to demonstrate skills learned in his/her absence would be unfair.

Behavior- It is expected that students behave well at all times—on stage and in rehearsal. Students must show re The Grizzly Strummers represent Grant and sets a standard for our school. If a student has difficulty meeting this expectation she/he may be dismissed from the group for the remainder of the year.

Commitment: The Grizzly Strummers is a year-long commitment, and will have focused learning every rehearsal to the end of the year. A student who leaves due to behavioral or academic concerns will not have an opportunity to return until next year. Please inform Mr. Mueller and/or the Office staff if for any reason a student will not be attending rehearsals.
